Vocation Corner: Age Range? Rev. Keith Romke

As the vocation director for the diocese, I am constantly talking to people about answering God's call for their life. The group I talk to most frequently are teenagers, followed by those in their twenties, and a handful in their thirties or forties. I'll admit that I don't give many vocation talks for those who are older than that. But this does not mean that those who are at or past what we would consider middleage don't have vocations any longer! God calls all of us to fulfill specific purposes each and every day whether we are 9,19, or 99! A child recently asked me how much longer I was planning on being a priest for! When I explained that I would be a priest for the rest of my life, they then asked what I planned on doing after I retire. I explained that I would still be a priest because it is not a job, it is a vocation! The same thing is true of marriage, or parenthood, or whatever vocation God calls you to! Will circumstances change when parents become empty nesters? Yes, of course they do, but they are still called to love and live out their vocation as parents and eventually as grandparents! It is just as important to be pondering God's will for your life at 60 or 70 as it is when you're in high school! So, no matter how old you are, I encourage you to daily begin your day by asking God what his plan is for you that day and then carrying it out with all of your heart!
